He oversees operations providing worldwide emergency command, control, communications, and software programming support 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to the President of the United States, Secretary of Defense, Joint Chiefs of Staff, and Combatant Commands. Additionally, he supports a secure airborne launch control system capability, and precise targeting for the nation's 450 Minuteman III ICBMs.

Chief Moore grew up in Malden Massachusetts and enlisted in the Air Force in April 1998. In addition to serving in various aircraft maintenance capacities, he's also served tours as a Military Training Leader, First Sergeant, and Inspector General Superintendent.
